<p>1</p>		<p>Starting the Client Application</p> <p>The WebMessenger icon will be displayed among the other programs if the application was loaded successfully. To start the WebMessenger application, you must select the WebMessenger icon by scrolling and tapping on it.</p>
		<p>This dialog allows you to create a new WMP account if you do not already have one. Tap on "Yes" to create a new account. If you have an existing WMP account, tap on "No" to connect with it. In the latter case a Login screen will be displayed where you can enter your User name and Pass word.</p>



<p>5</p>  	<p>Login</p> <p>From the login screen, enter your username and password to connect to the server. Tap on "Connect".</p> <p>Your buddy list will be displayed after a successful login. Several shortcuts can be used on this screen:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> m - send a message to the selected buddy n - next page p - previous page s - show Settings a - add a buddy g - show/hide groups o - show/hide offline users q - exit <p>Along with a display name, each buddy has an icon, showing the current online status:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">  online  busy,  away,  N/A (actual status is in brackets)  offline  unknown





Choose “Buddy” / “Subscribe all” from the menu.</p> <p>In the following screen you can subscribe to (receive the values of) this buddy’s properties. Subscribing is a process of sending a subscription request to the buddy. You will receive a notification whether your request was accepted or rejected.</p> <p><i>Hint:</i> The most important property is online-status. Subscribing to this property will allow you to see the online status of this buddy (<i>online, busy, away, offline</i>). You can subscribe to other properties (phone, e-mail) as well and will receive notifications when their values change.</p>


<p>9</p>		<p>Buddy Properties</p> <p>Select a buddy from your list. Choose “Buddy” / “Buddy properties” from the menu.</p> <p>Displays a list of all properties . By default all of them are selected. Tap on the second column to select / unselect individual properties. When you are ready, tap on “Ok”. Use “Cancel” to cancel this action.</p>
<p>10</p>		<p>Unsubscribe to Buddy Properties</p> <p>As noted, you can unsubscribe for individual properties at any time. If you want to unsubscribe from all properties of this buddy, choose “Buddy” / “Unsubscribe all” from the menu. This will bring up a confirmation dialog “Unsubscribe to <buddy name> properties?” – tap on “Yes”.</p>

You cannot change the UserID of the buddy, only the display name (“Current Name” and “New Name”). Tap on “Ok” to apply your changes.</p> <p><i>Hint:</i> If you added a buddy with an invalid username, delete it and add it again with the correct username.</p>

13		<p>Change Online Status</p> <p>From the menu, choose “My Status” and one of the items below: “Online”, “Busy”, “Away” or “Not Available”. This sends to the server your new online status and all users, subscribed to it will receive a notification. Your status icon on your device will change too.</p>
14		<p>Move to another group</p> <p>Select a buddy and choose “Buddy” / “Move to another group” from the menu to move the buddy from the current group to another different group from your list.</p>



The next time you start the application, the last username will be pre-filled in the login screen.</p> <p>“Save Password” will save the password from the last successful login and pre-fill it as above.</p> <p>“Auto Suspend/Resume” will perform an automatic logout. Your status will change to “N/A” not “offline”. When starting the application again, you will automatically login.</p> <p>“Background” you can remain connected to the server and receive messages from buddies even when working with other palm applications. The IM application remains in the background (“Preview messages”) and is always ready to accept messages.</p>

		<p>“Disconnected” show/hide buddies from disconnected IM networks</p> <p>“Expand the Buddy List on”</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Resume - expands the collapsed buddy list on resume -Receive message - expands the collapsed buddy list on receiving message -Receive status - expands the collapsed buddy list on receiving status
19		<p>Settings: Messages</p> <p>Configures message screen options:</p> <p>“Auto display incoming msgs” select this if you want the message dialog to be displayed when you receive a message while you are in the buddylist view.</p> <p>“Use Enter key to send message” select this if you want to send the message with the Enter key.</p> <p>“View time stamp” is used to show/hide the timestamp in front of each message.</p> <p>“Msg storage per user” defines the size (in kilobytes) of the storage used for message history. There is a separate history storage for each buddy.</p> <p>“Total message storage” specifies the storage space, used for all buddies in total.</p>
20		<p>Settings: Notifications</p> <p>Configures the notifications for different events.</p> <p>“New message” and “Presence change” – you may choose sound/ vibrate to alert you when a message is received or a property value is changed.</p>

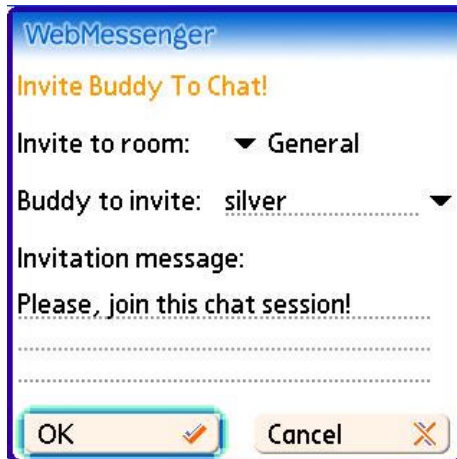

Using Multi-User Chat

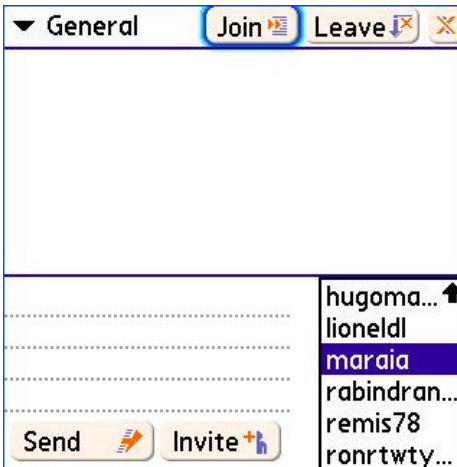
This client supports real-time chat with rooms and multiple users. Choose "Options" / "Chat..." from the menu.

This screen displays a list of all available chat rooms on the server. You can select one to join in or you can create a new one. The popup list on top shows all rooms you are currently in. Use it for changing rooms.

Both private and public rooms can be created. Each room needs a description (room name). Public rooms are visible in the list (see above) while private rooms are hidden. You can join a private room only if you know its name, not by browsing.



Send an invitation to another user (select user from drop-down menu “Buddy to invite”) to join a room (choose from the list). You can also specify a message to be sent to the user you invite. An invitation can be accepted (the user joins to the room) or rejected (no notification is received).



This screen displays all users which exist in room “General”. You can Invite new user in the same room or crate a new room (tap on “Join”) and invite buddy in a different room (private or public). If you tap on “Leave” you would immediately exit from the room.

Using External Instant Messaging Networks

The client allows you to add and communicate with buddies from public instant messaging networks (ex. ICQ, Yahoo!, AOL, Skype, Jabber, etc.). Open the configuration by choosing “Options” / “IM Networks” from the menu.

The screen on the left displays a list of all supported networks and the connection status of each one. Connection status "Online" means your external network account (ex. Skype # John) is connected and online. "Unknown" means you do not have a registered account with the corresponding external IM network.

Use "Connect" and "Disconnect" to connect or disconnect from the selected IM network. "Add/Edit" and "Remove" allow you to add an account to the list and remove it, respectively.

Use "Import buddy list" when you add a network and wish to import your public IMI account's buddy list (ex. ICQ Contact list) into you buddy list. Allows you to import buddies in a single group or to keep groups. Before importing, you must be "Online" on that network.


