






WebMessenger Mobile Instant Messenger for BlackBerry




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1.		<h2>Install</h2> <p>If the application was loaded successfully, the WebMessenger icon will be displayed on the RIM ribbon (two envelopes with two arrows). To start the WebMessenger application, you must select the WebMessenger icon by scrolling over it with the track-wheel and clicking it. Using the shortcut button (the shortcut button is "w") is another option.</p>
2.		<h2>Login</h2> <p>When started, the WebMessenger application will bring up a log-in screen with "User Name" and "Password" fields. Type your user name and password and click on the track-wheel.</p> <p>Context sensitive help is available on most screens. The shortcut keys are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 'h' -help screen; - 'space' -Go to next unread msg; - 'shift+space' -Go to next property; - 'n' -next page; - 'p' -previous page; - 'g' -show/hide groups; - 'o' -show/hide offline; - 'Esc'/'Backspace' -Switch to ribbon; - 's' -show Settings; - 'a' -switch between Buddy list screen and Activities;





<p>3.</p>		<h3>IM Networks Wizard</h3> <p>If you are logging in for the first time and your contact list is empty, the IM Networks Wizard will appear to guide you through the process of setting up your IM Networks. Fill in your User Name and Password for each external IM network (AOL, MSN, ICQ, Google ...) you have an account for and choose how you would like to import your contact list. If you do not have an account in any external IM network click "Skip" for all of the IM Networks Wizard screens.</p>
<p>4.</p>	<h3>Add Buddy</h3> <p>Select group: <New Group> Enter new group name: AOL Select IM Network: aol User ID (username): John Display name: John</p> <hr/> <p>For help select Help from the menu</p>	<h3>Menu: Add Buddy</h3> <p>Use this screen to add a buddy or to create a new group of buddies.</p> <p>[Select group]: group in which the new buddy will be added.</p> <p>[Enter new group name]: enter the name of the group (if it is a new one)</p> <p>[Select IM Network]: select AOL, MSN, Yahoo, ICQ, Sametime, etc. if the buddy is from one of these networks.</p> <p>[User ID]: type the exact username of the buddy in the IM network. For MSN specify the full name (e.g. john@hotmail.com).</p> <p>Hint: you can also select None as IM Network and type AOL/john as username.</p> <p>[Display name]: type a descriptive display name. If you leave this field empty, the username will be used for display.</p> <p>Hint: you can show/hide groups from the buddy list screen by pressing 'g' or show/hide offline buddies by pressing 'o'.</p>

5.		<h3>Buddy Menu: Message</h3> <p>Use this screen to send a message to a buddy. Type the message and select Send from the menu. The character '>' will be shown in front of the message while it is in the process of sending. The '>' will disappear when the message has been sent. An 'x' will be displayed if the message cannot be delivered. You can configure some of the screen options in Settings / Message Options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - messages to be sent on hitting 'Enter'; - number of messages to be viewed in the screen; - timestamp of messages; - message history size;
6.		<h3>Buddy Menu: Subscribe</h3> <p>Use this screen to subscribe for various buddy properties. You will see a list of properties supported by this buddy. The 'Online Status' property will ensure that you will be able to see the online status of the buddy (online, busy, away, offline). You can subscribe for other properties (phone, e-mail) and be notified when the buddy updates them. Choose the properties you want to subscribe to and select Subscribe from the menu. This will send a request for subscription to the buddy. You should receive a response whether your subscription request is accepted or rejected.</p> <p>*Note: buddies on the 3rd party networks have only 'online-status property'. The subscription request for these buddies will automatically be approved by the server.</p>

7.	<p>Move "john" buddy to another gr...</p> <p>Current Group: AOL</p> <p>New Group: </p> <p>For help select Help from the menu</p>	<h3>Buddy Menu: Move to Group</h3> <p>Moves a buddy between groups. Choose the destination group and select Move from the menu. A buddy can be assigned to only one group at a time.</p> <p>Hint: you can show/hide groups from the buddylist screen by pressing 'g'.</p>
8.	<p>Rename john buddy.</p> <p>Current Name: john</p> <p>New Name: <input type="text"/></p> <p>For help select Help from the menu</p>	<h3>Buddy Menu: Rename Buddy</h3> <p>Allows you to rename the display name of a buddy. Type the new name and select Rename from the menu. You can only change the display name, not the User ID of existing buddies in your buddylist. If you have entered a wrong User ID and need to correct it, delete the buddy and add it again with the proper ID.</p>

You can configure some options for this screen in Settings / Message Options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - auto add messages to history; - history storage size;





You will see a list of properties supported by this buddy and their values.</p> <p>Note: buddies on the 3rd party networks have only 'online-status property'.</p>

If the Buddy is online, a shaded head icon is displayed; if the Buddy is offline, a non-shaded head icon is displayed. A half-shaded head is indication for status different from online and offline.</p>

You can join a chat room and you can see your active conversations.</p> <p>This screen displays a list of all available chat rooms on the server. You can select one to join or you can create a new one.</p>

	 	<p>Invitations invite users to chat rooms. You can also specify a message to be sent to the user you invite. An invitation can be accepted (the user joins to the room) or rejected (no notification is received).</p>
15.		<p>“Status” tab</p> <p>Online Away Not Available Busy Custom Status</p> <p>From the “Status” tab you can select “Online”, “Away”, “Not Available”, “Busy” or “Custom Status”. For buddies from other messenger systems their original online status info is mapped to the existing WMP Client states, as they may have a variety of states specific for this messenger system only. The custom online status works only between WMP clients, it does not work with other IM networks.</p>
16.		<p>“Settings” tab / About</p> <p>Displays information about the application version and build number.</p>

17.	<p>Active conversations settings</p> <p>Activity timeout: <input type="text" value="10 minutes"/></p>	<p>“Settings” tab / Active Conversations</p> <p>Configures the timeout for a chat to be considered an active conversation. Conversations are shown in the Activity screen and removed after the specified period of inactivity (no messages exchanged).</p>
18.	<p>Create Alert Rule</p> <p>Subject: <input type="text" value="<anyone>"/></p> <p>Other: <input type="text"/></p> <p>Condition: <input type="text" value="says"/></p> <p>Parameter: <input type="text" value="becomes"/></p> <p>Actions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Sound/Vibrate... <input type="checkbox"/> Pop up Notification... <input type="checkbox"/> Forward to... <input type="checkbox"/> Reply with... 	<p>“Settings” tab / Alert Rules</p> <p>Configures the rules for alerting on new messages and events. A message box is displayed when the alert condition is met. You can also configure an audible notification in 'Notifications / Alerts'. There are two types of alerts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - when a buddy uses a specific word in its messages ('says' rule); - when a buddy changes its status ('becomes' rule); <p>Use the menu to Add, Delete or Edit existing rules. Rules are restricted to 256 characters which can be one long rule or 4 shorter ones. When adding new rules:</p> <p>[Subject]: select the buddy name from the buddylist or type it in the 'Other' field. Select <anyone> if the rule will apply to messages from all buddies.</p> <p>[Condition]: select 'says' or 'becomes'.</p> <p>[Parameter]: type the phrase to search for ('says' rule) or the online-status string ('becomes' rule) -'online', offline', busy', 'away', 'n/a'.</p>




<p>20.</p>	<p>Chat settings</p> <p>Auto refresh chatroom list Yes</p> <p>Select Timestamp Standard</p> <p>Storage size for events 32</p>	<p>“Settings” tab / Chat</p> <p>Configures the options for the multi-party chat feature:</p> <p>[Auto-refresh chatroom list]: will refresh the list of chat room on entering the 'Activities' screen.</p> <p>[Select Timestamp]: format of the timestamp in front of each message.</p> <p>[Storage size for events]: storage for events in KB.</p>

21.		<p>“Settings” tab / Export / Import settings</p> <p>[Export]: allows you to export your settings through email [Import]: tries to find automatically setting list to import in the Inbox folders</p>
22.		<p>“Settings” tab / IM Networks</p> <p>This screen shows the current status connections to 3rd party networks (logged in or logged out). Use the menu to:</p> <p>[Login]: login in to a specific network (highlight the network first) [Logout]: logout from a specific network [Create/Edit Account]: manipulate the proxy account of the selected network [Import Buddy List]: import your buddy list from the selected network [Remove]: remove an IM network [Check connectivity]: to refresh the status of your connections to other IM networks</p> <p>Note: you can still be able to connect to an IM network, even if it is not on the list. The connections are established based on the information you have entered in My Account web page (third party messengers). This screen provides convenient way for checking the status and selectively connecting to specific networks.</p>
23.		<p>Menu: Connect Disconnect</p> <p>Connects or disconnects the selected IM network.</p>

<p>24.</p>		<h3>Menu: Import Buddy List</h3> <p>Imports buddy list from the selected IM network. The buddies can be imported in a single IM group or in the same group structure you have in the IM network you are importing from.</p>
<p>25.</p>		<h3>“Settings” tab / LogStore Settings</h3> <p>Use this screen to enable the system log. The system log is used in debugging and reporting a difficult to reproduce problem. In order to obtain the logs please follow the following procedure:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Select LogStore Setting and Set "Logging" option to Enabled. 2. Exit the application. 3. While on the ribbon (with all other application icons) type ALT-Iglg (hold the ALT or CTRL key and type "Iglg" -these are the letters L G L G). A debug screen will open (EventLogger) 4. Select Options from the menu in this screen. Set "Min Log Level" option to "Debug Info". Scroll down in the window, open the menu again and select "Show all types". Save the changes on exit. 5. Try to reproduce the problem again. 6. Go back in the debug screen - ALT-Iglg. Find an entry called "Java Exception", highlight it and select View from the menu. Select Copy Event from the menu. 7. Go in the mail application, create a new email to contact@webmessenger.com and Paste the log in the body of the email. Send the email.

[Message]: sets audio/vibrate settings for incoming messages. In addition you can set whether the incoming messages are to be displayed immediately on the screen ('Instant Display Message'). [Property]: sets audio/vibrate settings for changes in online status and buddy properties.</p>

31.		<p>Menu: Switch to Ribbon</p> <p>Ribbon mode allows the WebMessenger application to work in background mode. This means it runs “hidden” so that you can work with other RIM applications. When you are finished working with the other application just select the WebMessenger application icon and you will be brought back to WebMessenger’s buddylist screen.</p>										
32.		<p>Menu: Exit</p> <p>If you want to logout press the track-wheel and select “Exit”. A warning message appears. Select “Yes” and you will be logged out.</p>
